<b>Colorectal Cancer Screening</b>	<b>3017F</b>	Colorectal Cancer Screening results documented and reviewed. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Colonoscopy in the past 10 years, or</li> <li>• Flexible Sigmoidoscopy in the past 5 years, or</li> <li>• Fecal Occult Blood Test (FOBT) in the current year</li> </ul>
<b>Blood Pressure Control</b>  Note: Same codes may be used for telephonic encounters	(Members ages 18-85 with a diagnosis of hypertension and whose blood pressure during the measurement year in the outpatient setting is controlled (under 140/90))

<b>Advance Care Planning</b>	<b>1157F</b>	ACP present in medical record, <b>or</b>

<b>Medication Review</b>	<b>1159F</b>	Medication list documented, <b>and</b>
	<b>1160F</b>	Medication list reviewed
<b>Pain Assessment</b>	<b>1125F</b>	Pain assessed, <b>pain present</b>
	<b>1126F</b>	Pain assessed, <b>no pain present</b>
<b>Rheumatoid Arthritis Management</b>	<b>4187F</b>	DMARD prescribed or dispensed

	2024F	7 standard field stereoscopic retinal photos with interpretation by an Ophthalmologist or Optometrist documented and reviewed with evidence of Retinopathy
